## Competition Format:

There will be four separate competitions:

<b>SERVICE</b>	All Service matches that are shot at a State Titles from <b>now to <u>30 November 2020</u></b>
<b>WA1500</b>	All WA matches that are shot in the State Titles from <b>now to <u>30 November 2020</u></b>
<b>ISSF</b>	All ISSF matches that are shot at a State Titles from <b>now to <u>30 November 2020</u></b>
<b>BLACK POWDER</b>	All Black Powder matches that are shot at a State Titles from <b><u>now</u> to <u>30 November 2020</u></b>



## Prizes to be Won

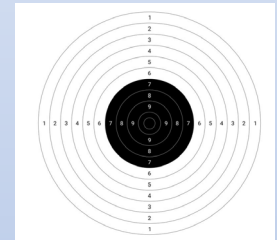


- All matches must be shot according to the match rules. Score sheets are required to have:

- Your Name
- Date
- Grade
- Event/Match
- Signed by RO or Club Official

## TIPS

- Only one score per match to be submitted.
- Approach it like you would for a normal competition, *ie pick a date to be your "Competition Date" – send in your score for that shoot – it's not about your best results over the 2 months...it's your "Competition" result.*
- Scores can be from a Club Competition or a Sanctioned Competition.
