The week of shooting will run as outlined below!

Competitors will be met at the Norfolk Island airport by representatives of the Norfolk Island Pistol Club.

Once you and your firearms have cleared Border Force your firearms will be transported to the Armory for the duration of your stay on Norfolk.

Saturday the range will be open from 12pm until 4pm for practice and equipment control.

The opening Welcome Fish Fry will commence from 5:30pm at the range.

Sunday – Wednesday shooting will commence at 8am daily, good luck to all.

Lunch will be available at the range from 12 noon until 1:30pm.

All events will be completed by 5:00pm Wednesday.

Thursday the fun event, consisting of a mixture of shooting different targets with different firearms, your air pistol and club 0.22's. You will need 20 air pellets and a box of 50 0.22's.

Lunch will follow the fun event at the range.

Border Force will attend the range from 1:30pm to process your departing Norfolk forms.

The cases will be sealed there and then stored at the armoury until your day of departure.

On the day of departure your firearms will be taken to the airport, prior to checkin Border Force will check the seals on the cases and then date and stamp your form. Then checkin can take place.

Step 1 Print the last page of this document, the check list for travelling with firearms.

Step 2 **Border Force CCID Number**

Obtain a CCID number by filling out the below form on the link.

If you have travelled before you will have a CCID number already.

Step 3 **Travelling with 4 or less Cat H firearms. (If more than 4 go to step 6)**

Complete a Restricted Goods Permit (RGP), listing all firearms, magazines and ammunition.

A long with a copy of your valid firearms licence and certificate of registration.

Step 4

Complete a Border Force Export Declaration (ED) form b957, first firearm only and then use the Export Declaration Supplementary (EDS) form for all other firearms and ammunition.

Step 5 **Submit the RGP, ED and EDS forms to Border Force.**

You can only submit these forms 28 days prior to travelling.

You will get them back with your Export Declaration Number (EDN) 7 days before you travel.

Contact the Defence Department via the below website to registrar for a DRCN and then complete a Export Control Form.

When you get the Defence Export Control back, approved, you need to complete steps 4 and 5.

Step 7 Norfolk Island B709's

Contact Doug Creek at dougcreek@ymail.com for B709A (ammunition) and B709D Cat H firearms, for Norfolk Island Police approval to import firearms.

Step 8 Your return journey home

Complete a new RGP, ED and EDS for leaving Norfolk. Border Force will check these forms and seal the firearm cases ready for your day of departure.

Step 9 Airlines

Confirm with your travel agent or directly with the airline that you are traveling with firearms, They usually require make, model, serial number and ammunition quantity.
