N O T E S	<p>Note 1: All listed matches begin the first match firing series at the advertised time. Prep time and the sighting series are held before the advertised time inline with ISSF Rules. Official Matches may start earlier if correctly supervised by a Range Officer and the range is full. All Listed Matches will follow ISSF Rules, Commands and Timings as per the Pistol Australia Match Run Sheets</p> <p>Note 2: The Club shoots on the 1st Sunday of every month from 9am to 12pm as determined by The Committee and only while it is attended by members. Any match can be shot provided there is a minimum of three members. The nominated Sunday may be changed by the committee at any time.</p> <p>Note 3: All members are required to take part in at least three (3) Working Bees each shooting year. A Levy of \$40.00 will be imposed for each one of the three working bees missed . There are Seven (7) working bees per year. Note: Juniors, Women and Probationers are exempt.</p> <p>Note 4: Members are reminded of their attendance obligations under Firearms Regulations 2006 Part 9 Clause 96 "Participation requirements for club members (cf 1997 cl 81)" A Minimum of 6 Competition Organised matches over each period of 12 months i.e.: 01/11/2021 to 31/10/2022. For each Type Of Pistol Category owned i.e Air,Rimfire,Centerfire you must complete at least Four (4) shooting activities for each of the categories owned. Refer to Firearms Registry Website for Full Explanation of requirements.</p> <p>Note 5: An attendance can only be recorded by the submission of a SCORE with the club scorer. If shooting away at another club then it is the members responsibility to obtain a signed score sheet from that club and provide it to the club scorer. IT IS NOT THE CLUB SCORERS ROLE TO CHASE UP EXTERNAL SCORES FOR A MEMBER.</p> <p>Note 6: Shooting may only occur at the club when there is a non shooting range manager and at least two other members. There must be a non shooting Range Officer, Range Manager and at least two competitors for a non sheduled shoot to be counted as a score</p> <p>Note 7: There are Classic Service matches held on the 1st & 3rd Saturday of the month for those who wish to take part with a 10am Start.</p> <p>Note 8: Service Pistol, 25 Yard Service and Classic Service Club Championship matches may also be shot on the Sunday provided the club is open.</p> <p>Note 9: Members are reminded that the Club Annual Fees must be paid on or before the 30th of April (half yearly payments) and the 31st of October.</p> <p>Note 10: Air Pistol Training may be conducted each Wednesday Evening starting at 6.00pm during Dayligh Saving months if a non shooting Range Officer and Range Manager is available.</p> <p>Note 11: Rifle Matches are .310, .22lr or Air Rifle ONLY due to our Range Template restriction. Pistol calibre rifles must be chronographed to ensure velocity and muzzle energy are below template values</p> <p>Note 12: AIR PISTOL - The KPC Air Pistol Range is Available for Use Whenever the Club is Open (Subject to the Scheduled Air Pistol Matches and Interclub Matches Indicated in This Calender).</p> <p>Note 13: <u>All Matches are subject to range availability, the Range Approval and conditions including fire risks as set in the Range Standing Orders.</u></p>
